1ST CYCLE ACADEMIC STUDY PROGRAMME OF KINESIOLOGY

Duration of the programme

The programme lasts for 3 years and has 180 ECTS credits.

Access requirements

Access requirements that have to be met to enrol in the first year of the study programme of Kinesiology are: matura examination or any four-year secondary school programme completed before 1 June 1995.

All candidates must successfully pass the test of motor abilities and skills.

If enrolment is to be restricted,

the candidates will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

- performance in the test of motor abilities and skills
- overall achievement in the matura or school-leaving examination 45% of the points, 15% of the points.
- overall achievement in the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} years

Documents required

All candidates must submit a **health certificate** with a personal health history which should contain data on severe injuries and diseases and the ability to bear greater psychophysical loads. The health certificate that has to be issued after 4 May 2015 can be issued by a GP. If the GP considers it necessary to obtain a specialist's opinion, the latter must also be enclosed. The candidates must send the above-mentioned documents to the Faculty of Sport by 29 May 2015.

If the candidate is a categorized athlete according to the criteria of the Slovene Olympic Committee, s/he can also submit a certificate of categorization issued exclusively by the Slovene Olympic Committee (Slovene Olympic Committee – Association of Sports Societies); the certificate is taken into account when awarding points in the test of motor abilities.

By the deadline set in the general part of the pre-enrolment announcement, the candidates will be informed in writing about all the details of the test of motor abilities.

1ST CYCLE ACADEMIC STUDY PROGRAMME OF SPORTS TRAINING

Duration of the programme

The programme lasts for 3 years and has 180 ECTS credits.

On enrolment in the first year, the candidate chooses an elective course (sports discipline) which should be in accordance with the documents proving the candidate's sports/coaching history. The candidate can choose from the following sports disciplines: Alpine skiing and snowboarding, athletics, badminton, biathlon, marshal arts, ice hockey, kayak canoe, cycling, basketball, table tennis, football, volleyball, swimming, dancing, sports climbing and alpinism, handball, ski jumping and Nordic combined, cross-country skiing, sports gymnastics, tennis, triathlon, water polo, rowing.

Access requirements

Access requirements that have to be met to enrol in the first year of the study programme of Sports training are:

a) matura examination;

- b) vocational matura examination in any secondary-school programme and the examination in one of the matura subjects; the subject chosen should not be the same as the subject the candidate already passed in the vocational matura examination;
- c) any four-year secondary school programme completed before 1 June 1995.

All candidates must successfully pass the test of motor abilities and skills.

If enrolment is to be restricted,

the candidates under a), b) and c) will be selected on the basis of the following criteria:

 performance in the test of motor abilities and skills 	40% of the points,
- overall achievement in the matura, vocational matura or school-leave	ing
examination	45% of the points,
- overall achievement in the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} years	15% of the points.

Documents required

All candidates must submit a **health certificate** with a personal health history which should contain data on severe injuries and diseases and the ability to bear greater psychophysical loads. The health certificate that

has to be issued after 4 May 2015 can be issued by a GP. If the GP considers it necessary to obtain a specialist's opinion, the latter must also be enclosed. The candidates must send the above-mentioned documents to the Faculty of Sport by **29 May 2015**.

The candidates must submit the **documents** proving the following:

- their past and/or present sports or coaching history; this should be certified by the club, sports association or the Slovene Olympic Committee;
- if the candidate is a categorized athlete, s/he should submit a certificate of categorization issued exclusively by the Slovene Olympic Committee (Slovene Olympic Committee – Association of Sports Societies)
- a certificate of a potential qualification in the area of sport (instructor, teacher, trainer, etc.).
